1.	CISGENDER	Publicly revealing the sexual orientation and/or gender identity of someone else who has not chosen to reveal it themselves.
2.	НОМОРНОВІА	The fear, hatred, or intolerance of lesbians, gay men, or any behavior that is outside the boundaries of traditional gender roles.
3.	TRANSGENDER	Originally a derogatory label used to insult lesbians and gay people. This term has been reclaimed and used as an umbrella term describing anyone whose sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression is non-conforming to societal expectations regarding gender and heterosexuality.
4.	PANSEXUAL	An umbrella term for people whose gender identity and/or gender expression differs from what is typically associated with the sex they were assigned at birth.
5.	BISEXUAL	A general term constructed to describe variations of sex characteristics. This could include mixed chromosomes, elements of both male and female reproductive systems, or genitalia that do not appear clearly
6.	INTERSEX	male or clearly female at birth. : A person who is attracted to people regardless of sex, gender
7.	COMING OUT	identity, or gender expression.  A description for a person whose gender identity and assigned sex at birth align
8.	QUEER	A person who is attracted to people of their own gender as well as other genders.
9.	QUESTIONING	Refers to individuals who are in a process of figuring out their sexual orientation and/or gender identity
10.	OUTING	The process of acknowledging one's sexual orientation or gender identity to oneself and/or individuals in one's life; often incorrectly thought of to be a one-time event, this is a lifelong and sometimes daily process.
